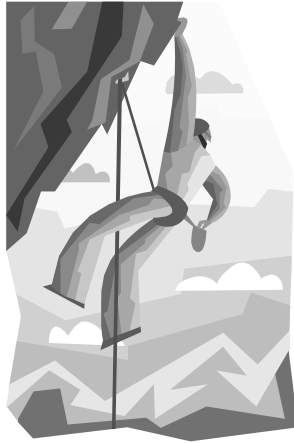


Hold the Rope!
